

The Old Bakehouse was built in the early 1930s by Wally Sexton.

#### DESCRIPTION

The Old Bakehouse is constructed of timber weatherboards with a corrugated iron roof. The building is in a state of disrepair with many broken and boarded-up windows. There is no access to the inside of the building and the condition of the interior is unknown however it is understood that the original wood-fired oven is still in place.
