HISTORICAL NOTES

Templemore was the home of James Kearney, an early resident of Nannup. Mr Kearney purchased Lots 2 & 3 Warren Rd in 1896.

DESCRIPTION

Templemore is constructed of brick walls with a corrugated iron roof. A residential extension constructed of timber weatherboards was added to the rear of the building in the early 2000s. A low brick wall is constructed at the front of the property which replaced the original timber picket fence.
