1920'S - CHAFF SHOP SUPPLYING LOCAL FARMERS

1930'S - JACK LINDSAY'S STORE - STOCK AGENCY + CREAM COURIER FOR LOCAL DAIRY INDUSTRY

1940'S - FRONT FACADE ADDED AND BECAME APPLE PACKING SHOP FOR LOCAL ORCHARDS

1952-53 - BEGAN OPERATING AS LOCAL HARDWARE STORE

THE HARDWARE BUILDING/SITE HAS SIGNIFICANT CULTURAL IMPACT HISTORICALLY ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF NANNUP.
